1. The Government of the Punjab has received a credit (S.No S153- PA) from the International Development Association towards the cost of Punjab cities Governance Improvement Project (PCGIP) and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for below mentioned work according to Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits.

2. The Municipal Office Infrastructure, Municipal Corporation Gujranwala invites sealed tender from the eligible bidders for the repair works mentioned below

4. The last date for issuance of bidding documents is 07-03-2018 and will be received up to dated 12-03-2018 at 1:00 PM. Bids shall be valid for a period of Sixty (60) days after Bid opening and must be accompanied by security of 5% of Bid amount and shall be delivered to MOI MGS. The same will be opened after 30 minutes of the closing time in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend. The bidders shall submit two copies of bid and clearly mention as "ORIGINAL" AND "COPY" as appropriate. In the event of discrepancy between them the "ORIGINAL" shall be prevail.

5. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the bids and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder in figures as well as in words for each item in the Bill of Quantities (Bid Schedule) and provide a total price. Non-Compliance may result in rejection of bid.

6. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information consisting of total monetary value of construction works performed for each of the last 3 years; report of financial standing and valid certificate of PEC Registration. This information shall be used to establish through Post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work, using single stage two envelopes, 1 for technical and 2nd for financial.

7. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected.

8. Any bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion / pooling) will be declared ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.

9. All Rules of World Bank prevail in case of any conflict with PPA Rules / Works Rules.

10. The Payment will be made as per World Bank Policy as the Consultancy for Top Supervision of PCGIP Schemes is involved.

11. The bidding documents are available soon after the publication in press.

Special Conditions:

12. The bidder shall specify the name of product country of origin, Manufacturer he wants to offer.

13. The bidder shall include all taxes and duties in the bid price.
